


The number of nests started this year (29) was higher than the average as was the number of nests with eggs (23) and the number of nests that successfully fledged young. But the number of young that fledged (75) was considerably lower than the average (88). Both Blue Tits and Great Tits fledged on average only three or four young.


We had two Coal Tit nests but one was abandoned at the egg stage and we had two Nuthatch nests, only one of which was used. We had no Stock Dove or Marsh Tits nests this year but the Tawny Owls fledged two young successfully.

The most notable thing about the 2016 season is the lateness of the nesting. The mean first egg date for both Blue and Great Tits was 3rd May, the average being 24th April, only 2013 was as late (see final graph). Looking at the graph one can see that, in line with expectations, for the first few years the first egg date was getting earlier but then in 2013 this pattern was disrupted.
